POSITION DESCRIPTION

This is a leadership role, working in a manufacturing team environment to trim custom plastic parts. The Setup Technician is responsible for setting up CNC routers and ensuring parts meet blueprint specifications and quality standards. This role works closely with Supervisors, Quality Control, Programmers, and Operators. Responsibilities include but are not limited to those described herein.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Interpret mechanical blueprints and CNC programming to understand job requirements.
- Inspect and adjust machinery to specification on 3-axis and 5-axis routers, according to process and blueprints.
- Realign machine, change tooling, adjust offsets, re-calibrate limits, and repair minor malfunctions.
- Operate forklift to retrieve part fixtures and to load/unload fixtures onto routers.
- Load, run, and inspect first part to verify proper setup. Assist in monitoring parts throughout job.
- Work alongside Quality Technicians to measure parts and verify specifications.
- Recognize quality defects and collaborate with team to troubleshoot machine and part issues.
- Assist in training Operators. Act as an Operator to complete jobs, as needed.
- Maintain a safe and tidy work environment according to guidelines and standards.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be experienced in setting up and operating CNC machines.
- Must be thoroughly comfortable interpreting mechanical blueprints and applying to machining.
- Must be thoroughly comfortable using hand measuring equipment: caliper, micrometer, height gauge, etc.
- Familiarity with a CMM is a plus. CAD/Programming experience is a plus.
- Technical degree or trade program coursework is plus.
